What is the Navajo Government Reform Project?

The 1989 reorganization of the Navajo Nation Government was intended to be:

- Temporary to meet the immediate needs of the Navajo People.
- Propose a more responsible and accountable government.
- To provide separation of powers & checks and balances.
- Ultimately, have the Navajo People decide their government structure.
